6. The student needs a 2.0-3.4 grade point average.



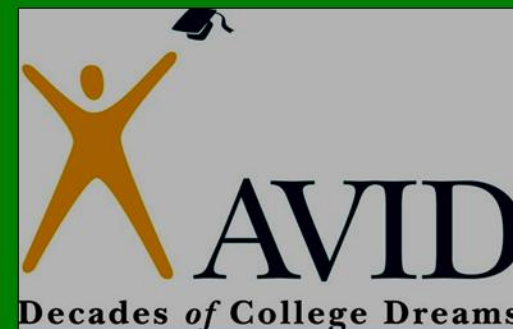
